Monday, November 21 – Zone 2 comingle. Zone 2 is south of South St.

Tuesday, November 22 – Normal garbage and yard waste. This is for North End, Heights, and Brookside areas. All yard waste must be in the can provided or a paper bag (no plastic).

Wednesday, November 23 – Wednesday and Thursday garbage. This is for Mayflower, Rolling Mill Hill, Iron Triangle, Goose Island, and South Wilkes-Barre areas. No yard waste will be picked up due to increased workload.

Thursday, November 24 – Off for Thanksgiving

Friday, November 25 – Off for Thanksgiving. Friday's garbage will be picked up on the following Monday.
